Who are we?

JERICHO is a charity and family of seven social enterprises that provide supported work opportunities for people facing challenges in getting a job.

These challenges could include trauma, insufficient work experience, health and wellbeing needs, education barriers and communication challenges. Currently we primarily support survivors of modern slavery and young people.

<u>The Wood Shack</u> reclaims, reuses, and recycles wood. We collect waste wood to sell it our timber yard and make bespoke wood products for customers.

















What's the job?

We are looking for apprentices to join our Wood Shack social enterprise. You will work with our friendly staff team for 12-15 months and be supported to achieve a level 2 qualification in customer service.

Throughout the apprenticeship, you will be supported by the ReUsers staff team and a People Support Officer who you will meet regularly to discuss any issues or concerns you may have with either the work or the apprenticeship study.

Towards the end of your apprenticeship you will be supported to move on to the next stage in your journey, this could be further study, paid employment or other opportunities.

Specific tasks include but are not limited to:

- Collecting wood from customers
- Sorting and processing collected items
- Keeping the warehouse clean and tidy and following strict Health and Safety procedures
- Serving customers
- Using tools to make items out of the wood
- Any other duties requested by the Line Manager

During the apprenticeship you will work with our training provider Next Level Training to complete:

- Level 2 Apprenticeship in Customer Service
- Level 1 Functional Skills in Maths & English, if you don't already have these qualifications.
